A Peek at the Week

*Theme: This week students will practice their parts and complete illustrating their character for our Water Cycle play. *Reading: Students continue to refine a few old strategies for Solving and then Checking Hard Words

* Writing: Children have started to add "sparkly" words - adjectives- while writing. These help make a picture in your head of what is being described while writing.

* Math: Chapter 12 Numbers to 40- comparing, ordering and noticing patterns in numbers. Depending on how well students understand these numbers, we will move on next week to chapter 13 which is addition and subtraction to 40

* Foundations: Final week of segmenting syllables, looking for words or parts of words we already known to read longer words.

* Theme: Exploring the rain forest, introduction and four layers. We welcome volunteers to help students build our hallway rain forest. From 10:30-11:15 days next week

* Math: Chapter 12:Numbers up to 40 then Chapter 13 addition and subtraction to 40
