- * Math: This week we will complete chapter 10 and start chapter 11 which focuses on picture and bar graphs.
- * Theme: Children will review the process of collecting sap to make maple syrup.
- * Reading: Students will add new strategies for solving & then checking hard words: Think about what's happening, think what kind of word would make sense, look for PARTS in words and the try it many ways before checking...Does it make Sense? Does it sound Right? Does it Look Right?
- * Foundations- final week of stretching out all sounds in words with five or more letters and adding a suffix: spends, clumps, chanted... practiced with nonsense words. Like proxes, stimping, quelted
