A Peek at this Week

- *Theme: Water Cycle Reader's Theatre play After choosing their desired role, partners will rehearse to achieve fluency and expressive reading together... highlighted script home today. To experience parts of the water cycle students will see Holling Clancy Holling's [Paddle to the Sea](#) on youtube.
- *Reading: Students added new strategies for Solving and then Checking hard words: think about what's happening, think what kind of word would make sense, look for PARTS in words and to try it many ways before checking...Does it Make Sense? Does it Sound Right? Does it Look Right?
- * Writing: Many students are now regularly making an effort to correctly spell their snap when writing. Most students are pointing at the words as they go back and reread to revise.
- * Math: We will spend this week on chapter 11 which focuses on picture and bar graphs.

Looking Ahead

- * Reading: Complete unit which focuses on strategies for students to use when they encounter a "tricky" word while reading or writing.
- * Theme: Water Cycle continues as students practice their parts for our Water Cycle play
- * Math: Complete chapter 11- Picture graphs and bar graphs using data to create and interpret information
- * Foundations: students will notice syllables while reading and writing focusing on breaking words into chunks of sounds.
