End of year assessments begin

- * Theme- This week, we will learn about the layers or zones of the ocean. In first grade, we focus on the three major zones: sunlit, twilight and midnight, the characteristics of each and creatures that live in these areas and why.
- *Reading: Read for information, nonfiction passages and books about life in the ocean, then answered questions.
- *Foundations: Vowel- consonant-e words, compound words and introduced then practiced with nouns and adjectives.
- * Math: Numbers to 120, place value then comparing, ordering and looking for patterns with these numbers.
