Homework this week includes discussing your family meeting place for fire prevention week.

- \* Math: This week we will complete Chapter 4- subtraction. At the beginning of the week we will make up subtraction stories, corresponding sentences and review fact families.
- \* Reading: This week [Readers Workshop](#) continues to build good habits when reading: do a slow check when stretching out sounds in words, review reading goals, when working with a partner;, do something at the end, ask if they want coaching or time to figure out a tricky word, look for parts inside words, and reread to check to see if the word made sense in the sentence
- \* Writing: Small Moment- zoom in on one part of our Friday science lesson: pollination. Students will use sequencing words to describe that part of the lesson when they were pollinating each other's paper flowers- [pictures on website](#) important to remember- cannot pollinate yourself.
- \* Theme: Apple tree seasonal sequencing, reviewed parts of a tree and read many books about apples. This week we will explore the pumpkin life cycle and then compare it to apples.
